Homeowner Protection Act — Strong Protection for New Home Buyers

The Homeowner Protection Act & its Regulations ("Act") became effective July 1, 1999. Prior to the issuance of a building permit, the Act requires all residential builders to be licensed by the Homeowner Protection Office (HPO) and to provide the "2/5/10" warranty from an approved third party warranty provider. What is 2510 Warranty?

The *Act* outlines specific details about the mandatory warranty commonly referred to as a "2/5/10" warranty. We believe it is the most comprehensive third party warranty available in North America.

Stringent Underwriting Criteria

The Homeowner Protection Act requires builders to provide a third party warranty covering:



2 Year Materials & Labour Warranty

- ⇒ First 12 months coverage for any defect in materials and labour
- ⇒ First 15 months coverage for any defects in materials and labour in the common property of a multi-unit building
- First 24 months coverage for any defect in materials and labour supplied for the electrical, plumbing, heating, ventilation and air conditioning delivery and distribution systems. In addition, coverage for any defect in materials and labour supplied for the exterior clading, caulking, windows and doors that may lead to detachment or material damage to the new home

A. 2-5-10 HOME WARRANTY COVERAGE:

1. Materials & Labour Warranty

- (a) Year 1 Any Defect in Materials and Labour
- (b) Year 2 Restricted to Defects in Materials and Labour supplied for:
 - the gas, electrical, plumbing, heating, ventilation and air-conditioning delivery and distribution systems; and
 - (ii) the exterior cladding, caulking, windows and doors that may lead to detachment or material damage to the new home,
 - (iii) coverage for any Defect in Materials and Labour which renders the New Home unfit to live in, and
 - (iv) subject to Subsection A.1.2, coverage for non-compliance or a violation of the Building Code.

2. 5 Year Building Envelope Warranty

3. 10 Year Structural Defects Warranty

B. HOW TO REGISTER A CLAIM WITH TRAVELERS INSURANCE COMPANY OF CANADA

If the Owner becomes aware of a Defect in Materials and Labour, a Defect in the Building Envelope, or a Structural Defect, for which Travelers Insurance Company of Canada provides coverage pursuant to the warranty certificate:

- the Owner shall promptly provide the Builder and Travelers Insurance Company of Canada with <u>WRITTEN</u> <u>NOTICE</u> outlining the full details of the defect.
- This notice must be provided on or BEFORE the Expiry Date of the applicable coverage for the New Home.

C. PROCESSING A CLAIM BY TRAVELERS INSURANCE COMPANY OF CANADA

- Upon receipt of the Owner's notice of a claim, Travelers Insurance Company of Canada will contact the Owner
 to outline the claims adjustment process.
- Travelers Insurance Company of Canada will advise the Owner of all decisions in writing.
- Repairs will be undertaken in a timely manner, with reasonable consideration given to weather conditions and the availability of materials and labour.
- Upon completion of the repairs, Travelers Insurance Company of Canada will deliver a copy of the repair
 specifications to the Owner confirming the date the repairs were completed and referencing the warranty
 remaining on the repairs.
- In the event of a dispute with Travelers Insurance Company of Canada, the Owner may refer the dispute to mediation. A mediator will be appointed to assist the parties in negotiating a mutually acceptable settlement of issues.
